From its beginning just over 100 years ago, Miami billed itself as a travel destination: Its first motto was "America's sun porch." Warm weather, sandy beaches and bright sunshine were its selling points then, and they remain a potent draw today. But America's sun porch has allure far beyond the U.S. People from all over the Caribbean and Latin America have settled there in the past 40 years, giving the city a new nickname, "the capital of the Western Hemisphere." As much as we love Miami's warm-weather fun, it's the city's lively, international character that sets it apart from many other travel destinations.

Though its residents come from all walks of life, it's the city's upscale sheen that most often catches the eye. The South Beach Art Deco District (or SoBe) is the center of Miami's trendy dining and nightlife scene, though its cheerful, neon-pastel buildings and palm-tree-lined avenues please the hip and unhip alike. Elsewhere in the city, Coconut Grove and Coral Gables offer their own versions of fine living. As attractive as these areas are, take time to enjoy the colorful happenings in other corners of Miami.

DAY ONE:

Lunch in the Art Deco District - Enjoy lunch at one of the trendy eateries of the Art Deco District.

Free time.

Dinner on Lincoln Road - Sample delectable dishes from the world's cuisines and enjoy the lively atmosphere of the Art Deco District.

DAY TWO:

Breakfast

Enjoy a hiking or bike trail, rent a canoe or kayak, try fishing or relax aboard a backcountry or bay cruise.

Miccosukee Indian Village and Airboat Rides - Witness craft making and alligator wrestling, learn about Native American folk traditions and take a fantastic journey on an airboat.

Monkey Jungle - Watch from special observation "cages" as nearly 500 primates of 50 species roam free in their tropical habitat.

Fruit & Spice Park - Featuring more than 500 varieties of exotic fruits, herbs, spices and nuts from around the world growing in a 30-acre living plant museum.

Prime Outlets at Florida City - Stroll through tropical, Mediterranean-style surroundings in a village setting featuring more than 60 manufacturer's factory-outlet stores including Nike Factory Store, Mikasa, Levi's Outlet by Designs, Nine West and more. Enjoy open-air shopping with children's play area and food-court eateries.

DAY FIVE:

Breakfast

Miami Metro zoo - Experience the excitement of the world's jungles in this 290-acre habitat, home to more than 1,000 animals representing 240 species.

The Falls Shopping Center - Enjoy lunch at your choice of restaurants within this open-air center surrounded by waterfalls. You'll find more than 100 shops, including South Miami-Dade County's only Bloomingdale's and Macy's and a 12-screen movie theater.

Free lunch and depart to Dadeland Mall - A favorite shopping destination for more than 30 years, Dadeland Mall is home to top names in retail establishments including the largest Burdines in Florida, Saks Fifth Avenue, Lord & Taylor and the country's largest The Limited and Express. Enjoy the fine cuisine of two full-service restaurants and 17 trendy food-court eateries.

Game Works - Work up an appetite at this unique entertainment destination, located in

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The Shops at Sunset Place. Created under the direction of Steven Spielberg, GameWorks features sat-of-the-art games that offer virtual experiences from fighting aliens to drag racing to skiing, as well as the full-service GameWorks.

Dinner in South Miami - Stroll along the Shops at Sunset Place and choose from the many quaint restaurants that the South Miami area has to offer.

Optional:

A Night in South Beach - If it is a specific club atmosphere you crave, South Beach offers a nightspot to suit all tastes: options include great reggae, jazz, pop, merengue and salsa venues, to name a few. Check out Gallery Nights, when the art galleries stay open late! **Optional:** Take in a play or catch a concert at one of the area's noted performing arts venues.

DAY SIX:

Breakfast.

Miami Seaquarium - Thrill to the shows starring Flipper and Lolita the Killer Whale, and encounter sea lions, sharks and manatees.

Lunch on Key Biscayne - Sample marvelous steaks or seafood at one of Key Biscayne's popular eateries. Afterward, depart to Vizcaya Museum and Gardens - this Renaissance-style bay front villa houses a priceless collection of 15th- through 19th-century furnishings and decorative arts. Outside are 10 acres of formal gardens, graced by several ornate fountains.

Bayside Marketplace - Shop and stroll through this lively retail and entertainment complex with its shops, artisans, open plazas, street performers and free nightly entertainment.

Dinner Downtown - Experience fine dining in one of Downtown Miami's upscale restaurants.

DAY SEVEN:

Breakfast.

Rest and relaxation - Enjoy a relaxing morning in greater Miami and the Beaches where you can pamper yourself at one of our luxurious spas or just relax on our beautiful beaches.

Optional: Water Sports - Whether you prefer the excitement of jet-skiing and diving, the challenge of deep-sea fishing or would rather take it easier in a kayak or canoe, Greater Miami and the Beaches have a water sport for you.
